The Institute of Intercultural Management and Communication or ISIT is a French Grande École.

In 1957, ISIT was founded as an association. This school offers diploma programmes in Intercultural Management and Communication, Translation, and Conference Interpreting. Graduated students from ISIT find employment in various professional fields. ISIT is in Arcueil, outside of Paris. Some lectures and research seminars as well as continuing education sessions take place in Paris. To meet the growing number of ISIT students, a new building (Campus ISIT Arcueil) was opened in Fall 2015 at 23 - 25 avenue Jeanne d'Arc (94110 Arcueil) and includes classrooms, the head office, administration and finance department, library, lecture halls and the IT department.

Location

Arcueil is a commune in the Val-de-Marne department in the southern suburbs of Paris, France. It is located 5.3 km (3.3 mi) from the center of Paris. The town has a historical heritage of great interest, evidenced by the aqueducts of Arcueil and Cachan, the first building, the Aqueduct of Lutèce was built in Roman times to late second and early third century home of the guards or the St. Dionysius church.

The city also has other essential buildings to discover, like the chapel Perret, the Raspail house or the old town hall became the center Marius Sidobre, all protected under the Historic Monuments.

What happens after you apply:

1. After the deadline, our Study Abroad Team will assess your application.
2. If you are successful, we will send you a study abroad offer (via e-mail) and will give you some time to think about it. If we cannot offer you any of the three universities you applied for, we will be in touch with alternative options.
3. If you choose to accept the Study Abroad placement, you will be nominated by us to the partner university, after attending a compulsory face to face appointment with the study abroad coordinators.
4. Following the nomination (usually in the Spring), you will have to complete a registration process with the partner university to finalise your acceptance.
5. After you have completed the registration, the host university will send you an official acceptance letter (electronically or via post).
6. You will be informed by the host university about any other deadlines (course selection, accommodation etc.) so do keep an eye on your Aston e-mail.

Visa
