

Bank statements must have a logo and name (unless the name acts as the logo). They must be in English or have an official translation attached

Must have the date that the statement was printed/issued and be dated no more than 31 days before the date of your application

Must have your name matching your passport (or your parent's name, if you are using their statements). Address is not relevant

If you submit an electronic statement, the bank must stamp it with their official stamp, on every page being submitted (front and back) and meet all other criteria

Balance must remain above the required maintenance and tuition fee total, for every day of your statement including the closing balance, for a minimum of 28 days

Your statement must cover a minimum of 28 complete days (29 to be safe), with the last date of your statement being no older than 31 days, prior to application

Your statement must show your closing balance and not be dated more than 31 days before the date of your visa application. The closing balance must be either shown in Pounds Sterling (£GBP) or converted into £GBP on the date of your application using www.oanda.com
