Bocconi University was established in 1902 with an endowment from Ferdinando Bocconi, a wealthy merchant. It was the first Italian institution of higher education to grant a degree in Economics.

Today Bocconi is a university of international standing in the fields of Business, Economics and Law. It is a private non-profit university with around 14,000 students and 1,300 teaching faculty. It is in the process of moving to a 3+2 system under the Bologna process and currently offers 11 undergraduate programmes (3 years), of which two are taught in English, and 9 graduate programmes (MScs - 2 years) of which one is taught in English. It also has 23 research centers (10 institutes).

The campus is located in the center of the city.

Bocconi University is situated in **Milan**, the main city of northern Italy. Milan is one of the world's major commercial and financial centers, and one of the wealthiest cities in the EU. Courses Available

Students will choose from a range of modules taught in English from the Bachelor of International Economics and Management program.

Class format is mainly lectures, but, depending on the subject, case discussions and presentations in class are also used. Classes have between 20 -100 students attending.

Living in Italy

- **Accommodation**

Bocconi has private student residences and also has agreements with other residences in Milan. Housing is limited and rooms are allocated on a “first come, first-served” basis. 4. Following the nomination you must complete a registration online using their application form. You will need to send with your application three passport-size pictures a CV, a copy of your academic transcript and a Personal Data Protection Code Form.

6. Complete a Learning Agreement once your modules have been approved by your Placement Tutor
