**Nagoya University** was established in 1871, it is a Comprehensive University with a rich history, with 9 Undergraduate and 14 Graduate Schools currently accepting students. It is highly accomplished as a Research University, as demonstrated by the fact that 6 of the 13 Japanese laureates to receive the Nobel Prize after entering the 21st century were affiliated with Nagoya University. Nagoya University is also making great efforts towards international exchange, and over 10% of Nagoya University's 16,000 students are international students from overseas. Many courses taught in English are being offered to encourage and increase the number of inbound international students. Systems are in place to support international students with their academics as well as daily living, including housing facilities for students who have never visited Japan before, appointing faculty members as International Student Advisors in each School and Graduate School, and a well-established counselling system.

[Nagoya](#) → Nagoya is located at the centre of Honshu (the main island of Japan) with a population of 2.24 million. Nagoya has a long history and is the birthplace of three notable feudal lords, Oda Nobunaga, Toyotomi Hideyoshi and Tokugawa Ieyasu. Traditional industries like ceramics and textiles as well as key modern industries like automobiles, aviation and machine tools have also developed in Nagoya, and Nagoya plays an important role in Japan's industrial society. Today, Nagoya continues to draw attention and keeps on developing as a Japanese international city.

## Work load

Each GLP course consists of 14 sessions, each 100 minutes in length, totalling 1400 minutes of contact time with teachers. Attendance in class is mandatory. Courses are assessed by examinations, individual assignments or group work, and graded on a curve.

The successful completion of a course earns 2 NUCB credits, which is directly equivalent to 3 ECTS credits. If exchange students' home institutions do not use the ECTS system, credit transfer is calculated on a case-by-case basis.

## Visa

The exchange coordinator will provide the necessary information throughout the process. Please ensure that you have an up to date passport before applying to enter or study in Japan.
