**The City**

Nancy, second urban center of the East of France, is the old capital of the Dukes of Lorraine. To benefit from it, stroll in the Old City, sit in the terrace of a café, visit the Gardens of Water, the Park of the Pépinière or one of the many other parks.

Nancy is also a town of culture, with its museums (Fine Arts museum, Ecole de Nancy museum, Iron museum, Lorraine museum), its Opera, its Ballet, its Lyric Symphony orchestra.

**Term/semester dates: Only for full academic year**

### Study Programme

Students will attend full academic year.

**Workload:** 30 ECTS per semester, 60 ECTS per year

### **Average costs:**

House insurance (for 1 year) €17 to €40

Meals at the University Restaurant €2,85

Meal at a pizzeria (with dessert, excluding drinks) €15

A coffee €1,50 to €2

Bus transport (student pass for 1 month) € 27

Cinema at student rate (there are cheaper rates depending on the times and cinemas) €5 to €6

Museum (certain days are free) € 2, 5 to €5

Social security (without supplementary insurance) per year € 195

Registration fees at the university or at another institution, per year (ERASMUS students and all exchange students are exempt from paying registration fees in the host university) €183 to €357

To stay in France you must be able to justify annual resources of roughly €5 200. But this is the strict minimum in order to get by.
