Application Process

Please note that you can submit one application only. As a part of the application, you must provide three universities in order of preference, which should also be specified in your motivation letter.

You are required to submit one motivational letter, which must be focused on your first priority.

The University of Đà Nẵng was established on April 4, 1994. VN-UK is a research-led institution base in Da Nang, Vietnam, in partnership with Aston University. The University of Danang is proud to be chosen by the governments of Vietnam and the United Kingdom to closely cooperate with partner universities in the UK to establish Vietnam – UK International Standard State University (VNUK) in Da Nang. VNUK receives great support from UK businesses and universities. One of the top 20 universities in the UK selected by the UK government, Aston University, representing the UK university association, offers support to VNUK in the curriculum design of many programmes such as: Foundation, Master, PhD, and Research programmes. VNUK lecturers are professors from partner universities, and Vietnamese professors who graduated from UK universities. Besides its innovative and advanced training programmes, VNUK is well-equipped with modern facilities, and located in the centre of Danang city, this definitely will bring students a wonderful learning experience.

Location

Da Nang is a coastal city in central Vietnam known for its sandy beaches and history as a French colonial port. It's a popular base for visiting the inland Bà Nà hills to the west of the city. Here the hillside Hải Vân Pass has views of Da Nang Bay and the Marble Mountains. These 5 limestone outcrops are topped with pagodas and hide caves containing Buddhist shrines.



Semester/Key dates

The academic year is divided into two teaching periods. Students can either attend for the whole year (September to June) or for one teaching period (either September to January or January to June).

Workload

Exchange student workload will normally consist of around 15 VNUK credits (30 ECTS credit) per teaching period. For students attending the whole year this is a total of 30 VNUK credits (60 ECTS credit).

Living in Vietnam

Next steps if you are successful

Visa

Step 1: You need to provide your scanned passport to our Research and International Office of VNUK via email

Step 2: VNUK will prepare some necessary visa pre-approved documents for you, then send them to International Cooperation Department and Vietnamese Immigration Department in Da Nang, Vietnam.

Step 3: Vietnamese Immigration Department in Da Nang will fax your result of visa to the Vietnamese Embassy in your home country. Then, you have to collect your visa at the Vietnamese Embassy in your home country and pay the visa fee.
