We will begin by storyboarding ideas for each scene, learn some simple editing techniques, add transitions, narration and export the movie to the Camera Roll or the web.

In no time at all, we will have produced an engaging short animation following the 12 frames per second rule, adding a voiceover and showcasing the results to the group
